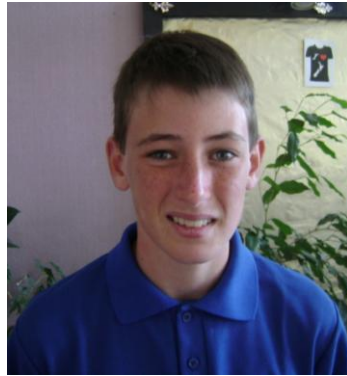


CCC Stars! These students have been awarded the CCC Shirt for consistently displaying the 3 C's inside and outside the classroom. Congratulations!
