WINTER AILMENTS

We have received notification from Health Waikato just to remind us all of gastroenteritis, 'flu like illnesses, measles, & sore throats which seem to lurk around at this time of the year!

All of these illnesses are spread in similar ways and the prevention messages are:

- Wash your hands
- Cover your mouth when you cough
- Carry out regular cleaning of all surfaces

Influenza like illness - most of our coughs, colds and sneezes are caused by viruses or bacteria which are spread by someone coughing and sneezing into their hand and not washing it.

Sore throats - can be caused by a number of viruses or bacteria. When a sore throat is caused by Group A Streptococcal bacteria, if untreated, can cause **Rheumatic Fever**. *Sore throats matter, if they persist, get them checked.*

Measles - symptoms can include fever, runny nose, cough, loss of appetite and conjunctivitis. *White spots may also occur in the mouth.* Measles are highly contagious and each case is likely to infect a further 12-18 non immune persons. **Should your child show these symptoms, it is crucial to seek medical advice so as not to risk further spread.**

Meningococcal disease - Although the numbers of this disease have decreased considerably, it is still expected that the Waikato will still experience 6-10 cases a year. Meningitis and septicaemia (blood poisoning) are not always easy to recognise and symptoms can appear in any order. In the early stages, the signs and symptoms can be similar to many other more common illnesses, e.g. 'flu. Early symptoms can include *fever, headache, photophobia (not able to look at light), nausea, vomiting, a rash and muscle pain, with cold hands and feet.*

Trust your instincts. If you suspect meningitis or septicaemia, get medical help immediately.
